

Inclement Weather/School Closings

In addition to the traditional 180 school days, three days are added to the (k-12) Diocesan School calendar each year to accommodate for days off due to inclement weather or other non-weather related emergencies. In the event these inclement weather days are not used, schools may dismiss for summer after completing the required 180 school days. If, however, during the course of the year, the school uses more than three inclement weather/emergency days, it is necessary for the school to adhere to the following schedule:

Each school needs to make up the first 5 days either by borrowing days from spring break or extending the school year. Days 6-10 do not need to be made up. For days 10 and on, schools can either add on the necessary days to their calendar or extend the length of their school day to make up those days missed due to weather and/or emergencies.
